### 12. Removal of XX YY requirement to bit his horses at events.

Requirement was imposed by SMC in 2015.

SMC agrees to remove requirement.

Moved to rescind requirement – Mark, Andrew. Carried

Mark to write to him rescinding, noting need to adhere to relevant rules re safety.

#### 13. Document retention

Ride paperwork needs to be kept for seven years. Responsibility of TEERA or clubs?

SMC - TEERA responsibility.

### 14. Sustainability

- a) Refunds 'With the apparent growing push for online payment I think we need to give this careful consideration and come to a position on this.' Suggested that this is a ROC issue not a TEERA issue. TEERA should have a position? Horse withdrawn before vetting rider may expect refund? Agenda for ROC / SMC meeting.
- b) Awards survey prepared by Kaye to be promoted and progressed Mark and Kaye. Tony Purton suggested we need a major award each year horse of the year?

### 15. Ride format:

- a) Need for more VGIH rides? SMC in principle support with allocated \$ for the extra vet that may be needed Mark to write to ROCs
- b) Need another 160k ride? good idea but difficult to arrange SMC support for vet \$ as above more encouragement provided as TQ25 approaches

### 16. Event traffic management

From Roger Nichols  $\rightarrow$  I was on the Stoodley checkpoint a few years ago (when traffic was also heavy due to a rowing event at Lake Barrington). This is a high risk section of the ride track.

Then, I took additional precautions, moving the checkpoint and deploying beacons (I carry in case of breakdown) and waving down fast moving traffic.

I wasn't at that checkpoint this year but did pass it in both directions. Signage was illegible until upon it (poor contrast between background and lettering) and, at Stoodley, poorly positioned along the road being on the wrong side of the brow of a hill.

I suggest a working party review road signage and its placement and TEERA supply appropriate signs to ROCs and a SOP on it's use.

There is a risk of biting off more than can be chewed. I suspect official advice might include hiring an accredited traffic manager.

#### 17. HHDs

From Graham Bucknell, NEEEC → as requested I question the point of the horse temperature log, when it first came out it was checked at the gate before any horse was permitted to enter ride base, now the form is taken to the ride office, it would be after the horse has been unloaded and if the horse had a problem the ride base would be contaminated, this why I feel it has no purpose we ether continue the practise of the check at the gate or scrap the practice altogether

Discussion: Form to be collected at gate. Mark to write to ROCs.

### 18. Ride nominations:

Progress of AERA platform? AERA nomination platform is being progressed. Work on this has commenced.

### 19. Early Warning System (EWS)

Nil letters this month – two riders, one horse on novice time – Trish?

#### 20. Novice tags on horses

The use of these has dropped off in recent years, particularly in light of the use of ETS which automatically flags 'under time'. Should we enforce the requirement to use novice IDs? Note, there is no Rule requiring this.

SMC discussion / decision - No requirement for tags – Mark to highlight to ROCs

### 21. TEERA Hall of fame

Some DAs have a section on their websites to feature their historical heroes. Should TEERA do this?

### 22. State Champs

MEER has offered. ROC has significant experience. 12-14 November. Mark to send STER budget to Mils for reference / planning. SMC congrats MEER on volunteering to run the ride. All clubs to be asked if they'd like to offer to run the SCs with a closing date for nominations of 31 May.

23. Pat Lamprey asked whether a horse outside the ring running alongside a horse in the vet ring is outside assistance. SMC discussion about what is and isn't allowable – no resolution as views differed.

#### 24. Kentish confidential matter

Andrew detailed an incident at the recent Kentish ride where a rider was seen kicking a horse in its yard at the ride base. The horse was objecting to having electrolytes administered. The incident was videoed by a member of another party and the video provided to Andrew. Andrew subsequently spoke to those who witnessed the incident and to the rider. He also discussed the issue with members of the SMC executive. The rider was asked to attend the SMC meeting to 'please explain'.

The rider explained that the actions taken, in hindsight, were excessive and that they regret their actions.

Outcome – rider to get a letter from SMC reminding them of both their horse welfare obligations and the need to take care to do nothing to bring the sport into disrepute. Andrew to provide personal feedback to the initial informants. Video recording to be deleted from Andrew's phone.

Some SMC expressed the view that the sanction imposed on the offender was on the light side.
